Please note – Depending on the type of cleft you have, you may not need to see every specialty. Also although reviews are grouped by 'age', patients may be slightly older/ younger. This is okay, as the aim is for that stage of development, not age itself.

Photographs



At these clinics, you may have photographs taken of your cleft lip and/or palate. These medical photographs are

kept in your hospital case notes; they provide a record of your development and help plan future treatment.

Sometimes, the team may use plastic guards to help keep your mouth in the right position when the photos are taken.

Cleft MDT Audit Clinics

What is an MDT Audit clinic, and when do they happen?

An MDT Audit clinic is an appointment where you see more than one specialty at the same appointment for routine records to be taken. Routine Cleft MDT Audit clinics happen at **5**, **10** and **15** years of age.

Please be prepared that your appointment may take a **couple of hours** as you will be seeing a number of different people

Cleft Surgeons will not be present at these clinics. If you require a surgical review we can discuss and organize this for you.
